Based on experience acquired through years of combat in Iraq and Afghanistan, Stronghold team members personally assembled, tested, and approved this product with the intent of reducing unnecessary loss of life by providing a product that can be utilized at the point of initial injury.

Stronghold team members assessed the products they personally relied upon in combat and created an easily portable kit that can be carried in a dismounted fashion or stored in a vehicle

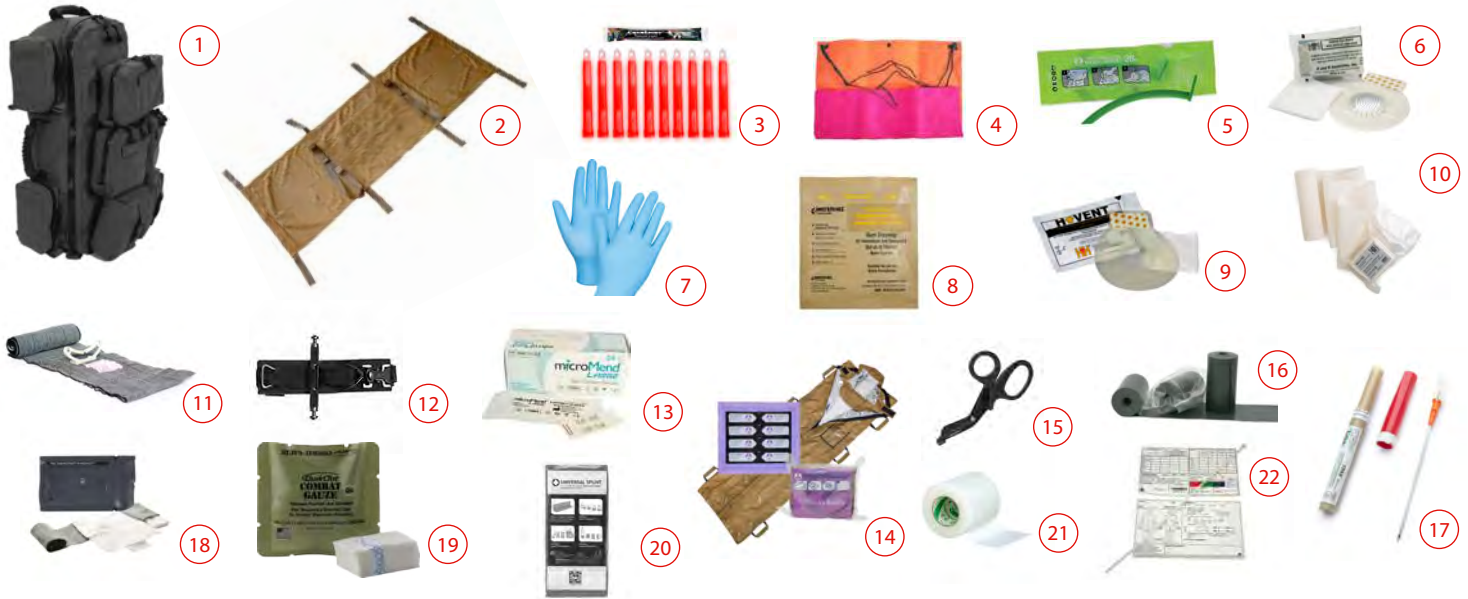
Combat Aid & Rapid Evacuation (CARE) Kit

The CARE kit is outfitted with a pole-less litter for quick evacuation of a non-ambulatory casualties utilizing a one-soldier to four-soldier pull or carry method. Due to the compact and flexible nature of the pole-less litter, this kit can be individually carried and employed with fewer personnel than alternative poled-litter options, allowing extra team members to focus on security and prevention of additional casualties.

The combat and modular design of the carrying bag allows front-line personnel to customize the size, fit, and load out of the essentials within the sack, tailorable to the soldier's specific and unique operating environment. Through experience in combat overseas, Stronghold team members determined that excessively heavy and/or bulky kits reduced maneuverability of front line treatment teams at a time when maneuverability is needed most.
